If you are based in Spalding or the surrounding area, you will know of Tulip Academy. We are a special school and cater for pupils aged 2-19 years of age, across two campuses.

On Waterside Campus (formerly known as The Priory School) we have pupils on roll who have moderate and significant learning difficulties. On Springview Campus (formerly known as The Garth School), we have pupils on roll who have significant and profound learning difficulties and complex health care needs.

For our pupils, Careers is not narrowed down to paid employment, or even a formal career which involves training and the potential to climb 'The Career Ladder'. For our pupils, the meaning of 'Careers' relates to an "appropriate and fulfilling destination after school".

We work (and have historically worked) closely with a number of further education colleges, adult social care settings and local businesses to ensure our pupils have access to varied work experience opportunities and through and bespoke transition packages to settings attended after school.
