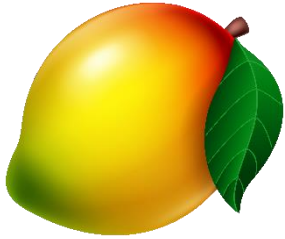


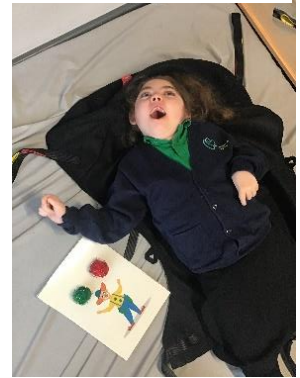
Tulip Academy Weekly News
