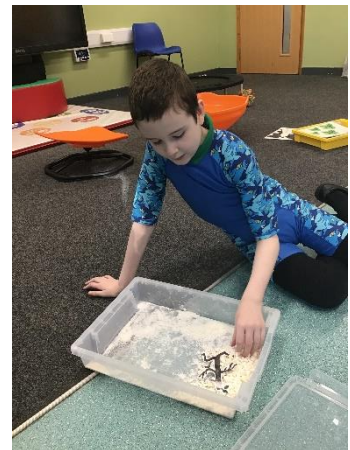
Mangos Class: This term, Mangos class have explored the topic 'Amazing Authors.' 📖

In maths and English pupils have been working hard preparing for their first set of formal exams. Everyone has worked extremely hard and should be very proud of themselves.

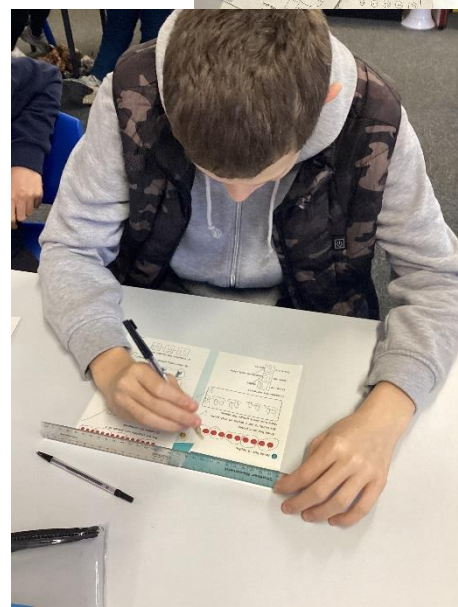
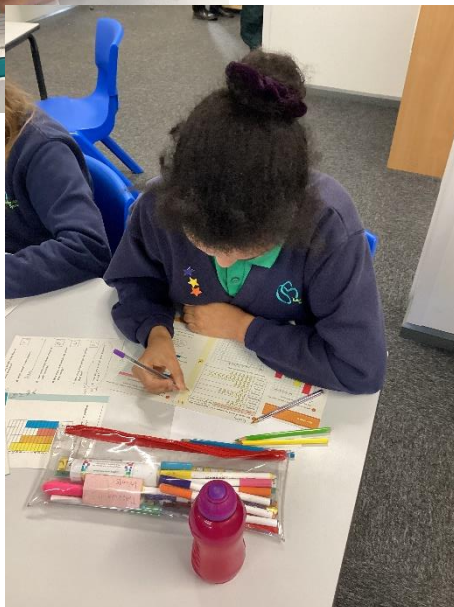
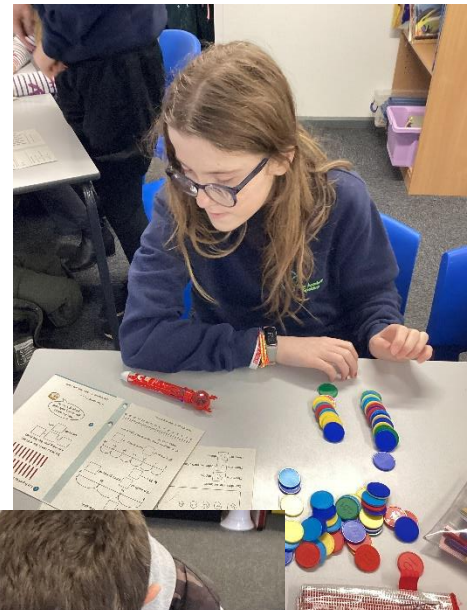
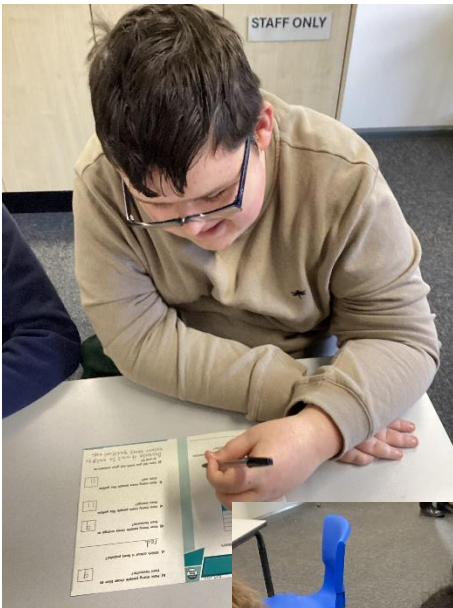
