Starter: PowerPoint with supporting resources

Fields and Forests: * crushed up Weetabix, angel delight and broccoli

green pine needle scented rice, wood slices and pine cones

Reed and Rivers: * blue oobleck and peeled courgette/shredded lettuce

* melted yellow and green teddy bear sweets (edible slime) * green larger pom pom

Cat and Dog: * furry fabric * toy cat and dog * felt cat cut outs


Bow: * tactile bows in blue rice * make making bow

Parachute to represent 'up' and 'down'





















Week 1: Potions and Lotions—Make a Magic Potion - Kids Halloween Song - YouTube - background: Snape's potions Classroom 27 [ASMR] Harry Potter An

- * essential oils—supporting chosen smells for potion * food colouring and paint
- * Fizzing cauldrons: bicarbonate soda, white vinegar and food colouring
- * Bubble cauldrons: cauldrons, straws, fairy liquid and food colouring * labelled bottles to encourage opening and pouring
- * Nature potion: water, mud and sticks
- * Foam cauldrons: cauldrons/bowls, foam soap/squirty cream and food colouring, spoons * Editable Halloween Potion Bottles (A4) English/Portuguese
- * Colour changing magic water: Magic Colour Changing Potions Science Activity The Imagination Tree * scented and textured cream to support massages

Week 2: Wizard of Oz The Wizard of Oz Fairytales for Kids Cartoonito - YouTube

- * Emerald City: Mark making activity, building with green duplo, green tactile materials * Tin Man: Explore tins, foil blankets and metallic objects
- * Bricks wrapped in yellow paper (yellow brick road), yellow stepping stones * Scarecrow: Stuffed clothes with hay, scarecrow (see story sacks), laminate scarecrow in hay and crushed up shredded wheat
- * Lion and Dog: sound buttons, symbols and objects * Tornado in a bottle: bottles, water, paint and glitter, fans and thunder musical instrument * Magic letter mark making
- * Green jelly—Elphaba * Whiteboard mark making—Wizards Interactive Colouring (teacher made) Twinkl

- * Light up wands

- * Tuesday: Farm yard animals, symbols and sound buttons, straw, yellow materials, chicks, yellow socks * Wednesday: Meadows –grass, grasshoppers, worms, lady birds, green materials, green laminated paper covered in toothpaste
- * Thursday: Fox –orange materials, leaves, orange scents and oranges * Friday: Butterfly purple flowers, purple materials, purple butterfly (TVHC box) * moat sand and water in tuff tray
