



Class News: Friday 16th May 2025


<u>Beech Class:</u> The topic this term for Beech class in English is 'Poetry'. Pupils have been learning all about language techniques used in poetry, to include onomatopoeia and alliteration. They have created some great tongue twisters and then edited them. It has been lovely to see their enthusiasm within lessons and the progress they are making.

In Science pupils have been learning about different types of forces. They have looked at gravity and friction.
