♠ We have also started attending horse riding lessons once a week! ♠ Ash class have really enjoyed learning all about the horses and how to ride! ♣
















They have also learnt about how to care for animals and have had great fun going to see the school pets to make sure they have food and water.

<u>Grapes Class:</u> This term Grapes Class have been focusing upon the topic: Weather and Seasons.

The pupils have engaged well with our story, linked to the text Mr Wolf's Week. A favourite part for many has been exploring 'windy weather', especially the fans blowing over their faces

or watching bubbles be wafted.







Explore and Discover sessions have seen us learning more about the different seasons. Many pupils enjoyed being able to sample ice cream and rocket lollies when thinking about Summer.



Getting stuck into the hot chocolate powder, whipped cream and marshmallows also went down a treat, when considering how to stay

warm on a Wintery day. Throughout our learning – both class-based and in the Multi-Sensory Room – pupils have had the opportunity to develop their communication: making choices, asking for 'more' and for some, using colourful semantics to make sentences.

We have been blown away by their work! Grapes Class really do shine!







<u>Willow Class:</u> Willow class have had a very busy Spring term and have been making the most of the good weather!

In Forest School, we have been pond dipping, exploring the area in a scavenger hunt and learning about different types of eggs!











The egg theme continued in Science, as we have been learning about the enamel that protects our teeth (very similar to an egg shell!). To test how different types of drinks affect our teeth, we submerged eggs in liquids with varying amounts of sugar (milk, cola, water and juice) and checked on them after a week. It was really interesting to see how the eggs shells had changed in colour, texture or thickness! We learned that drinks with lots of sugar ruin the enamel of our teeth!

We have also been hands on, designing and making our own battery-powered clocks of twas great to be so creative; we ended up with some really unique designs!

















Our English topic of poetry ended on a high with us all writing our own poem based on animals in silly places! We had flamingos on the football pitch, sugar gliders in a bookshop and a dog who became a lifeguard!
