STEM saw us experimenting with absorbent materials and finding out about solids, liquids and gases and our watery theme continued through our learning about capacity in Maths!

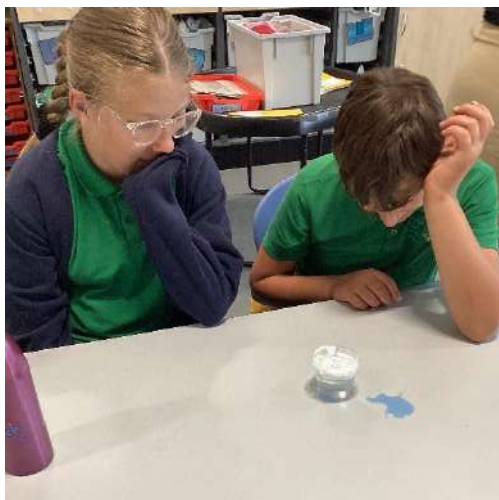
So, all in all, we've certainly "emersed" ourselves in this terms learning and kept cool at the same time!

We had a lovely day out to Wicksteed Park where we enjoyed lots of rides a picnic and fun at the park.

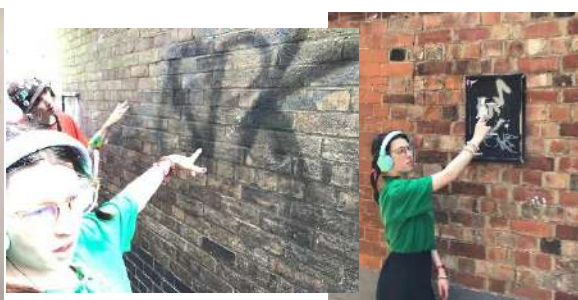
