P.E we will be learning target sports and through target sports learning how to throw and catch.

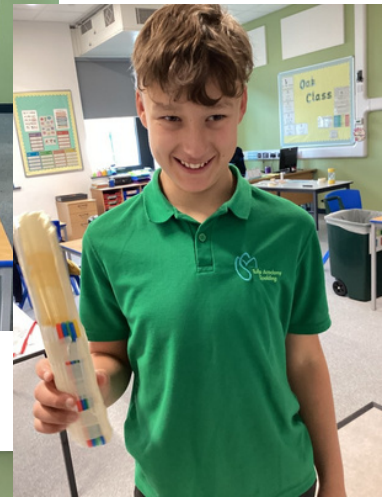
Looking forward to the term ahead.
