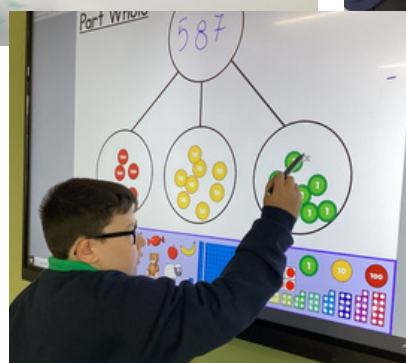
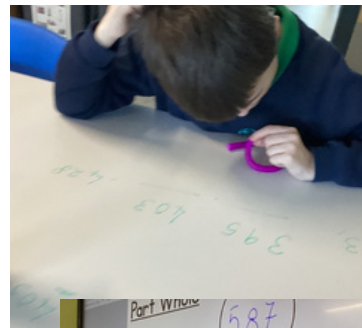
In cookery lessons, we developed our scone-making skills, aiming for everyone to be able to make them independently by the end of the term.

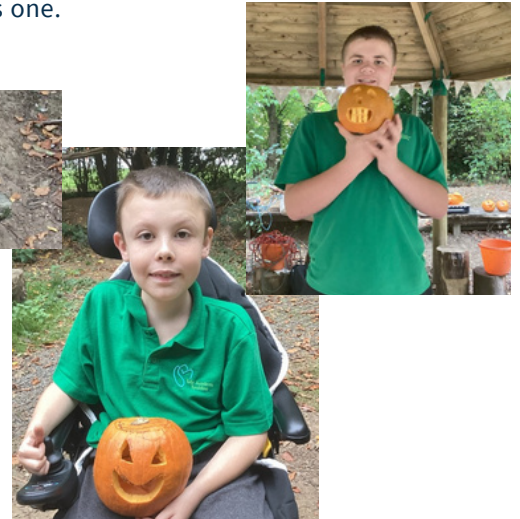


# ROWAN CLASS NEWS

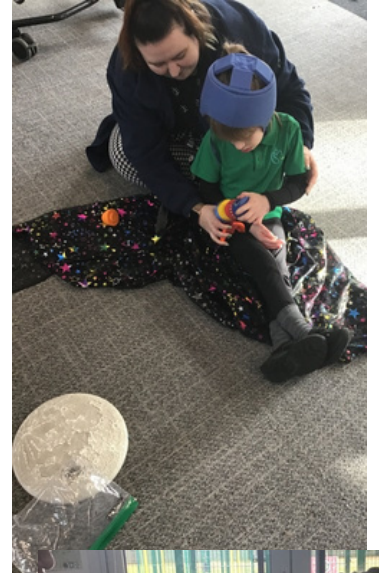
