We have had some great experiences this term. Starting off with a lorry simulator, that's allowed them to take control and experience driving a lorry.

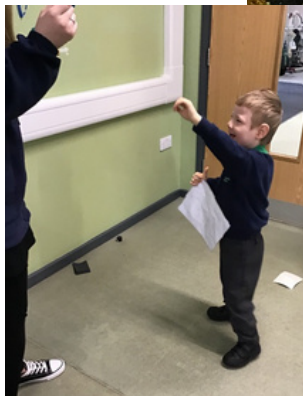
They have also had a knife crime workshop and were taught statistics and how the impacts of knife crime have on people in society.
