BIRCH CLASS NEWS



We have also been fortunate to spend time in our outdoor area, making the most of the new playground equipment.





Well done, Pears! It has been lovely to see your enthusiasm and how brilliantly you've joined in with all the activities.

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

CHERRY CLASS NEWS
