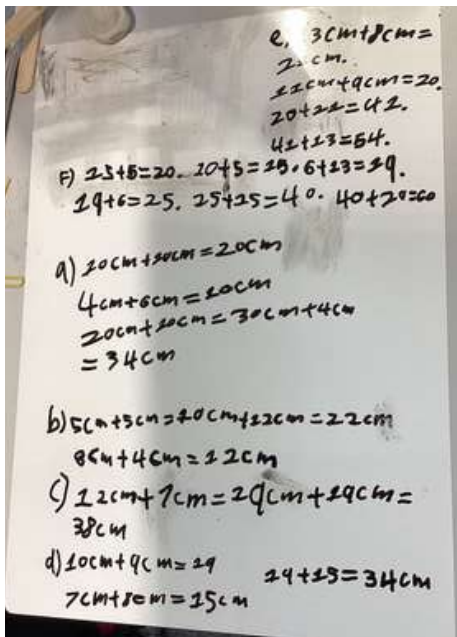
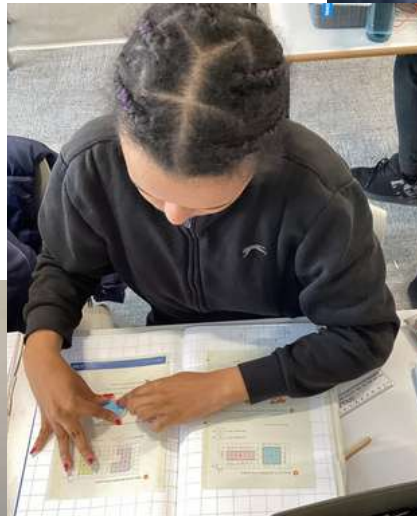


CLASS NEWS
