We encourage families to support this learning at home by practising regular handwashing routines and discussing ways to stay healthy together. Working together helps children develop lifelong habits for good health and hygiene.

MANGOS CLASS

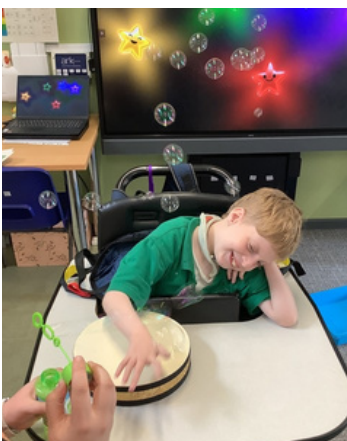
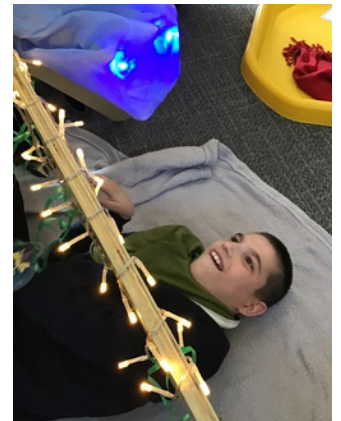


This term, Mangos Class have been exploring magical worlds as part of their term topic of 'Magic and Mystery' ✨
