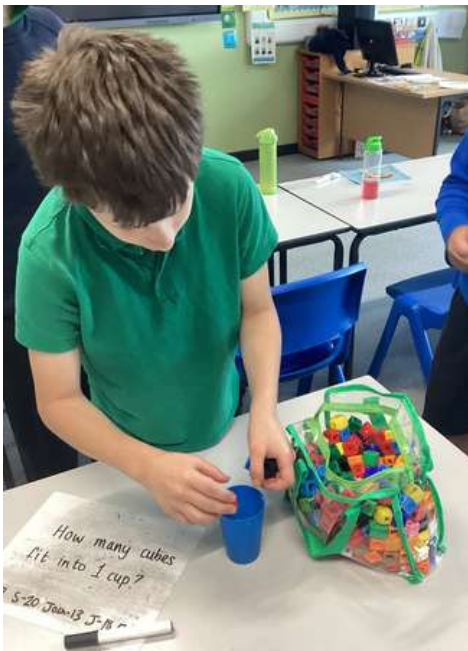


CLASS NEWS
