

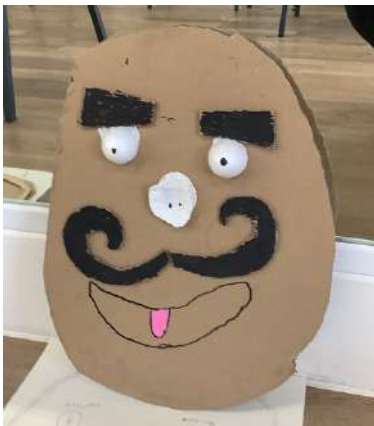
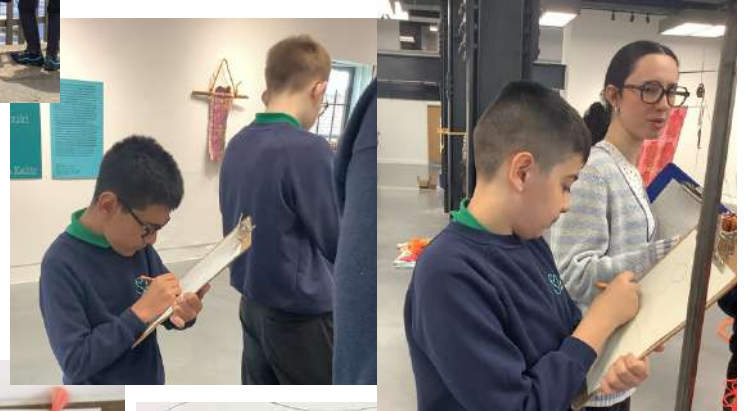
# CLASS NEWS
