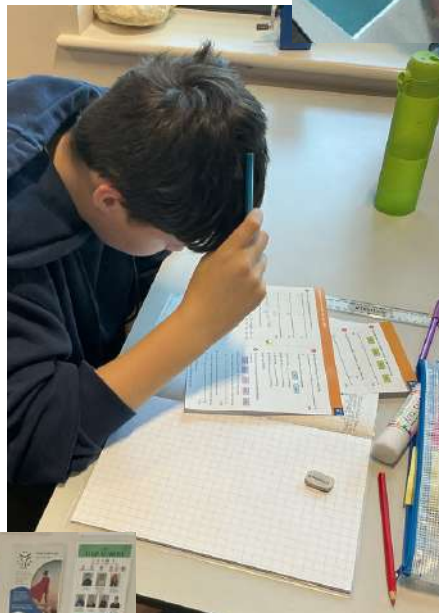
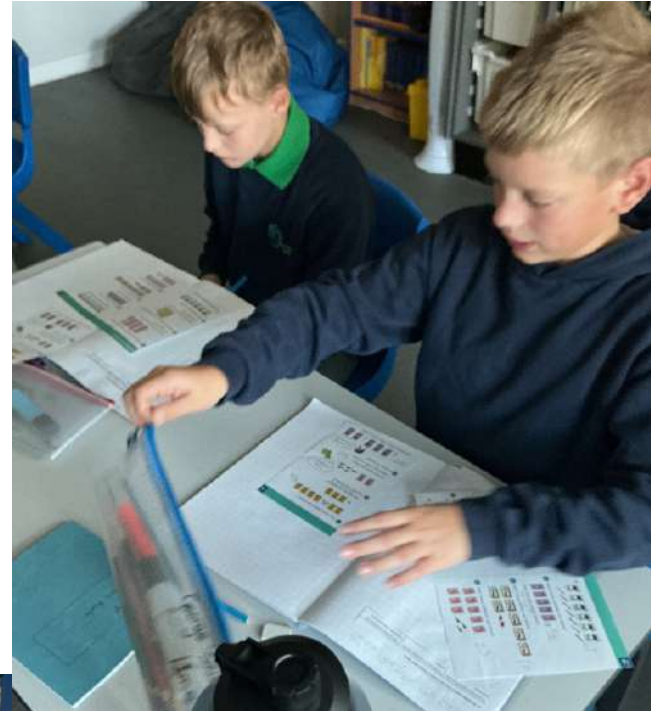


It has been a busy and exciting start to the year, and we are looking forward to seeing what the rest of the term brings!
